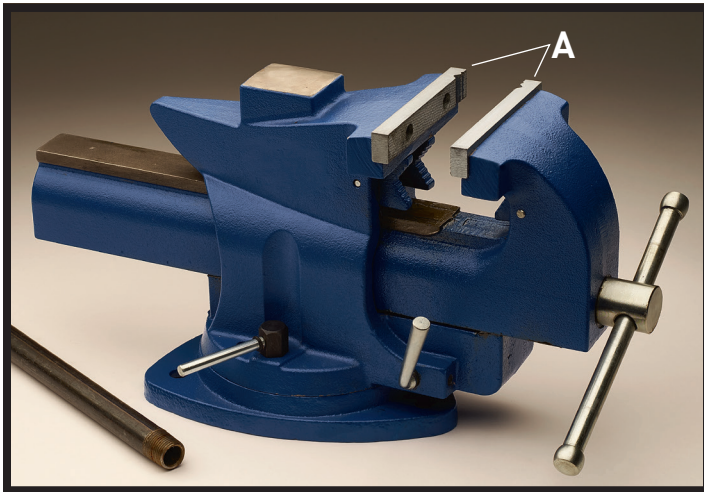


Thank you for your purchase of the Heavy Duty Shop Mechanic's Vise. Along with its heft and quick-release function, a key feature of the Shop Mechanic's Vise is the Replaceable Jaws. Please review these helpful tips.

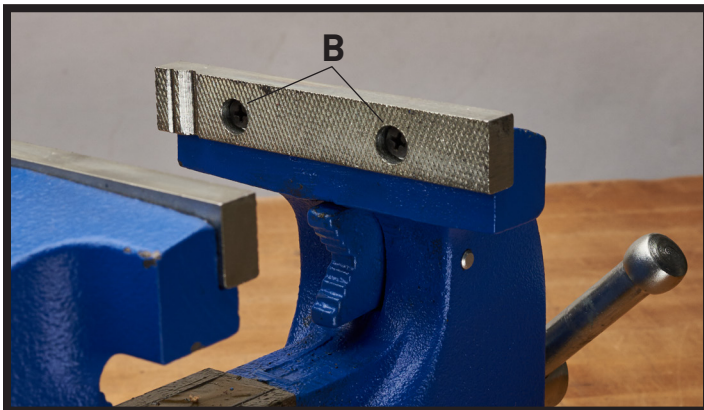


The Jaws (A) on this Shop Mechanic's Vise are replaceable, and can be quickly and easily removed to allow for the use of custom-built jaws.

Custom jaws are often made of wood, felt or rubber for use with delicate materials, or incorporate jigs for job-specific applications. Replaceable jaws expand the utility of your vise many fold and enhance the capabilities of your shop.

Instructions For Replacing The Jaws

- 1 With a Phillips screwdriver, remove the two recessed screws in each jaw (B).
- 2 Remove the old jaws and replace with the new jaws. Reinstall and tighten screws.



Please Note The images feature jaws with two small vertical V-shaped grooves (C). These grooves are for holding small cylindrical and very narrow objects (e.g. drill bits) and are 3/8 and 1/8" wide.

Unfortunately, we received a first shipment of the Vise that includes jaws with only the larger V-shaped groove. We have notified the maker of this error, and will be receiving the correct jaws soon (we anticipate March, 2016), which we will ship immediately on to you.

Please keep the single groove Jaws with our compliments and apologies for any inconvenience.
